



CHANGES TO UNIFORM GUIDELINES

effective fall 2022

- **ALL jackets and sweaters worn inside and outside the classroom must be solid navy, black, or white, plain with no logos**
- No pullovers or hooded sweatshirts
- Students must wear solid navy, black, or white socks except on House Spirit Days when house-colored socks may be worn.
- Only white t-shirts may be worn under uniform shirts
- Must always have a uniform shirt under jumpers (Peter Pan collared shirts are preferred.)
- **Athletic shoes only M-F** (tennis shoes or other shoes with traction on the bottom, lace-up or velcro straps, suitable for running and playing during PE and recess)
- No dress shoes, including ballet flats, oxfords, and mary janes, **except** on Spring Picture Day or unless stated otherwise
- No boots, Ugg type boots except on rainy days unless stated otherwise
- No Crocs or sandals except on Water Play Days
- No hats or beanies in classrooms
- Hats and beanies must be plain black, navy, or white, no logo
- On College Shirt Days, blue jeans without holes may also be worn
- On Spirit Days/House Days - house shirts with uniform bottoms or any dress code-appropriate clothing in solid house colors may be worn.
- Make-up may be LIGHTLY worn in grades 5-6



ADDITIONS TO FREE DRESS CODE

effective fall 2022

- No cut-off shorts
- No sweatpants except on House Spirit Days or unless stated as part of a spirit day theme
- No pajamas unless stated as part of a spirit day theme
- No fishnet stockings
- Length of shorts, skirts and dresses must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- Crocs and sandals okay ONLY on water play days
- Shoes must always be athletic shoes unless stated otherwise by the school
- Make-up may be LIGHTLY worn by grades 5-6

SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS



HATS

Optional:
Hats and beanies must be plain black, navy, or white, no logo



* No hats or beanies in classrooms

TOPS

White, oxford button down style shirts

No polo shirts!
Shirts must button all the way down.



Navy blue v-neck sweater vests are optional...

Navy blue ties may be worn on Tuesdays.



Any undershirts must be white

Chino style or khakis, No cargo pockets, no leggings, no jeggings!



Uniform shirts must always be worn under jumpers. Peter Pan collars are preferred.



Solid colors!

No logos!



BOTTOMS

Navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, dresses, and skirts.



Belts, if worn, must be solid black or navy.



FOOT WEAR

Athletic style, closed toe shoes--suitable for PE.



May be any color, lace-up or velcro

Socks, tights, and leggings (worn under skirts) must be solid navy or white*



All students must wear socks, tights, or leggings with their shoes.

*Black socks may be worn with pants.

ALTERNATIVE UNIFORM DAYS



WEDNESDAYS



College/University Day

Students may wear a college/university shirt or long-sleeved shirt or sweatshirt with uniform bottoms or blue jeans.



ASSEMBLY DAYS

No Free Dress for Award Assemblies

Students may not use free dress passes on these days.

FREE DRESS DAYS



Monthly Classroom Awarded Free Dress for Best Attendance

Some classrooms are awarded free dress on certain days for an entire month after the class wins best attendance. See the teacher for instructions.

FRIDAYS



Spirit Day

Students may wear their house shirt or solid colored t-shirt in their house color, and their lanyards with uniform bottoms or solid house color bottoms

Free Dress Passes

Students may receive free dress passes that they may use on any day besides Award Assembly Days.

Themed Free Dress Days

Students who choose not to participate in any themed free dress days must adhere to uniform guidelines.
